CODE OF PRACTICE 2006/02

Pursuant to section 25(1) of the Yukon *Occupational Health and Safety Act* R.S.Y. 2002, the Board orders as follows

1. This Code of Practice explains the requirements for standard hand signals to be used for controlling crane operations – crawler, locomotive and truck cranes. It provides practical guidelines to the Occupational Health and Safety Regulation *Part 5 - Cranes, Hoisting and Lifting*, sections 5.22, 5.24 and 5.33 to help determine what is appropriate for the particular circumstances of each workplace.
2. This Code of Practice applies to all workplaces as established in section 2 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act*.
3. Diagrams 1, 2, 3, and 4 (below) demonstrate the standard signals for controlling crane operations, crawler, locomotive, and truck cranes.

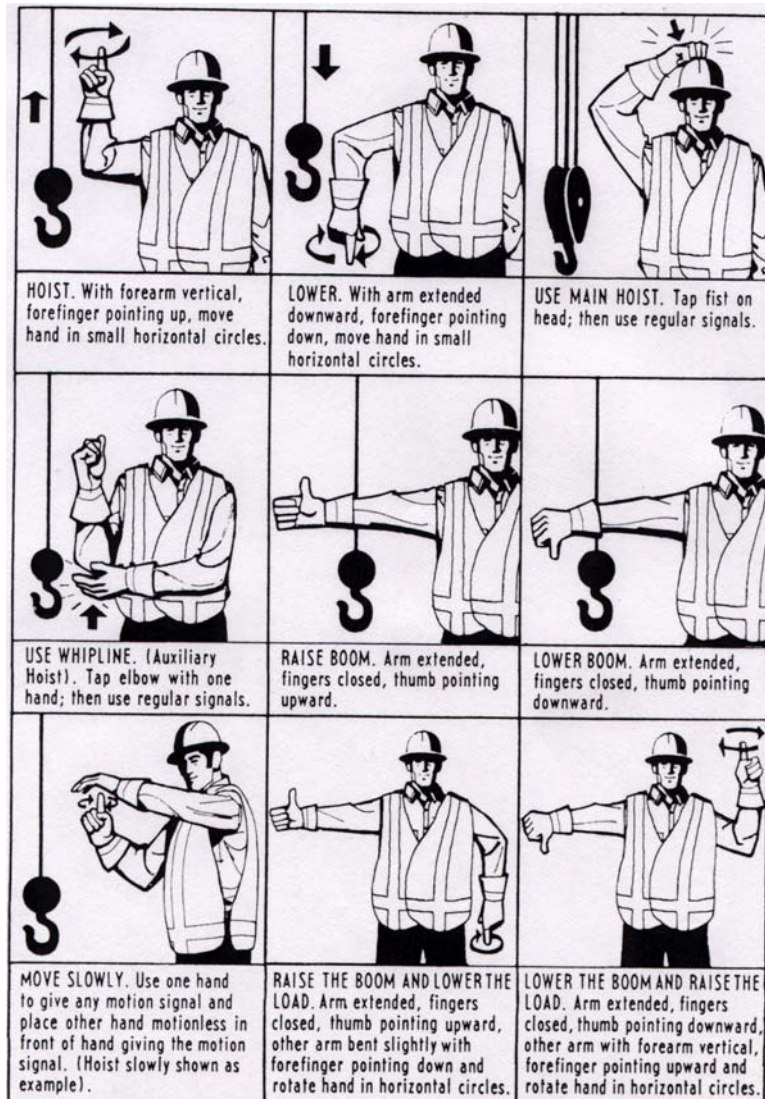
